SECTION V— Playground and Physical Fitness Equipment Preventive Maintenance and Inspections

- A. Play Area Preventive Maintenance—Play area preventative maintenance helps ensure that equipment and facilities are maintained in as safe a condition as possible. Following are general guidelines for play area and equipment maintenance:
 - 1. Maintain Protective Surfacing—Perform routine preventive maintenance on protective surfacing as needed or at least weekly by raking and fluffing surfacing material, putting surfacing material back inside the border, and picking up litter.
 - 2. Report any Play Area or Equipment Problems Immediately—The school administration must electronically submit an LCPS Facilities Services Work Order to report any problem, needed alteration, repair of loose/broken equipment, or parts of equipment. LCPS Facilities Services is responsible for overseeing all playground and physical fitness equipment repairs.
 - 3. Play Area and Equipment Repair Warning Signs—Repairs will be expedited by LCPS Facilities Services. However, schools shall put up warning signs, cones, caution tape, etc. when repairs cannot be scheduled or completed immediately.
- B. Play Area Equipment Inspections and Evaluations—Who inspects, when and what—LCPS recommends a comprehensive inspection and maintenance program for play areas and grounds, identifying equipment and repair/replacement needs.

The School Administration is responsible for the overall safety of the school facility. |
| LCPS Safety and Security | Annually or as needed Inspections | LCPS certified playground inspectors shall inspect playgrounds at least annually or periodically and when problems or concerns arise. |
| LCPS Facilities Services or other qualified designee | As Requested and Needed | LCPS Facilities Services is responsible for play area and equipment repairs and replenishing mulch in the play areas. Vendors and contractors may be utilized on an as needed basis. |
