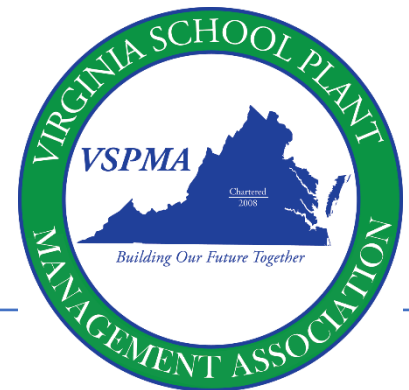
I have gained extensive experience in my two-year term, and I look forward to what the future holds for us all.
